General Information

NCITS offer individual students and Extension Center students the opportunity to complete a course of study at their own chosen pace that will lead to the earning of appropriate awards for Christian ministry and service.

The course is composed of **units** and **modules** .

- a. **unit** - a bracket of modules
- b. **module** - a single subject of study

Students may receive a Certificate for each module if that is all they enrol with NCITS for, or they may receive a Certificate/Diploma for completing either a single unit or a number of units to complete a nominated course.

1. Each Unit can be accomplished within a 9 month period of time.
2. Ideally a student would seek to progress through the five stages sequentially, each Unit building on the previous Unit's focus.
3. If a student has already accomplished equivalent study modules at another institute, the student may be exempted from the NCITS module, but must first gain that exemption by completion of the Prior Learning information required in the application. All such exemptions are given in writing and are part of the formal Letter of Assessment & Offer that a student receives on enrolment.
4. If a student has been exempted from completing approved equivalent modules, they will be required to complete a replacement Elective Text Study Analysis to learn the same semester credits. NCITS nominate the replacement study text. Students utilizing this exemption are required to complete a written paper answering given questions.
5. Students who do not want to complete all written assignments for each module may audit the course at reduced fees. If the student desires at a later date to complete the course at the given credit level, the full fees must be paid, and the written assignments completed to satisfactory level.
6. Students who desire to increase their annual credit load and are able so to do, may elect to complete additional study modules by Elective Textual Study modules as nominated. Each study module requires the student to submit a written research paper of no less than 2500/5000 words in accordance with the model Elective Text Modules (available from NCITS Student Handbook), or answer the given questions with no less than 500 words per chapter.
